Vertex:	$-\frac{b}{2a}$ (x-coordinate)	$\frac{p + q}{2}$ (x-coordinate)	$(h, k)$
Axis of Sym:	$x = -\frac{b}{2a}$	$x = \frac{p + q}{2}$	$x = h$
X-Intercepts:	<b>graph or change forms</b>	$p$ and $q$	<b>graph or change forms</b>

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
